Comments from the Editors and Reviewers:

Reviewer Comments to the Author  
R1:

I think there's a good paper in development here, but it is not clear what you are trying to do or how that has informed your choices. In general, you need to explain things more carefully and clearly.

R2:

1. The basic diagnosis of the pandemic as an ecological and environmental phenomenon is an interesting one. But what are you trying to do in response? If you are trying to develop a spiritually- or theologically- informed response then you need to say so.

2. Why did you choose these three thinkers to resource your argument? I can guess at an answer (because Indonesian is made up of Muslims and Christians; so you are synthesizing ideas from a Muslim and a Christian thinker, along with one who represents Indonesian cultural spirituality to produce a vision that can be shared by all Indonesians) but this is just my guess - you need to tell your readers

3. If you are clear about what you are doing, it will help you to be clear about the purpose of your long descriptions of the work of each of the three thinkers. At present, these lack focus: for example, we don't need to know where each one was born. Help your reader to understand why you are giving all this information

4. Then explain what you are doing when you draw their main ideas together. Clearly there are some parallels and some complementary ideas. Are you trying to bring them all together into a single model for how we as human beings are part of our environment?

Finally, you need to explain more clearly the status of the diagrams in Figures 1 and 2. Are these your attempts to synthesize core concepts from the three thinkers into a single system? Does figure 1 derive from your discussion on pages 17-20? If so, please explain how it derives, as I cannot see the connection. Similarly, explain how figure 2 is derived and what it means for our response to the pandemic
