Recheck the citation and reference format carefully. Some typos and errors! Checking the lower case, upper case, no abbreviation for journal names, and use consistent doi format. And some typos for English writing were identified.

I want to see the real implication of this study for nursing practice, especially for family nursing or community nursing. Perhaps, the authors could add one subheading "Implication for nursing practice" before conclusion part.
