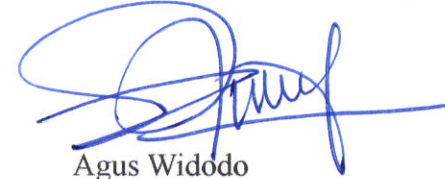

Recommendation: Revisions Required

1.

Article meets all formal demands (i.e. title, abstract, keywords, structured content, bibliography).

2.

The title of the article does not conform to the content of the article.

3.

The abstract conforms to the content of the article.

4.

The keywords conform to the content of the article.

5.

The structure of the article is logical and transparent.

6.

Text is grammatically correct.

7.

Scientific terminology/vocabulary is correctly applied.

8.

The bibliography is representative for the topic of the article.

9.

The conclusions reflect the presented argumentation.

II Remarks to the formal assessment

The article contains all the required elements that have been combined into one whole by the Author. Individual chapters (parts) follow each other in a logical order. The basic conclusion that emerges from reading it is that it is a type of "narrative" and does not reflect the thoughts of Saint Augustine and his works. The title says "based on", or rather it should be "reference to". The summary, especially the Introduction, is general (beginning) and too long and requires rewording.

III. Reviewer's decision

2. The article can be published after implementing the Reviewer's suggested changes.

IV. Substantive justification of the Reviewer's decision

The article puts emphasis on an important dimension of the dynamics of human upbringing, which is the ontological dimension. Referring to the Author of such works as "De Magistro" or "De doctrina christiana" is by all means advisable and necessary, especially since the development of the latter corresponds to the creation of the first three books of "De Civitate Dei".

If the author bases his considerations on "The City of God" (TCG), he should refer to Augustyn's statements (he was quoted only 7 times and recalled twice - this is about the TCG) or his individual words, which in the original are in Latin, they should appear in the content anyway, and not only in what others say about him. The few quotations from Augustine's work do not reflect his thoughts, and the terms mentioned, e.g. "conscience" and not "conscientia" - do not reflect their richness.

V. Specific comments and recommendations for the author

Sticking with the expression "based on" requires rewriting the entire article, including the summary, so that conclusions emerge from Augustine's statement, and not so that the conclusions are documented with a few quotations.

A long introduction (especially its first part) is completely unnecessary, and point 1 requires rewording: The Socio-Cultural Context.... In exchange for general and commonly known content, I suggest presenting the general characteristics of Augustine's work as Augustine's revision of classical ethics. It is worth emphasizing: Augustine's sharing of Cicero's opinion about the fall of law and justice in Rome (Book II of the TCG); striving to base ethics on the desire to exercise virtues and not on strictly pragmatic effectiveness (V TCG, chapters 12-16); the "gemina caritas" (X TCG) criterion; "De finibus bonorum et malorum" (X, 32. 4; XIX, 1.1. TCG); characteristics of book XIX; abolition of any temptation to dualism (XIV TCG); the famous formula "uti-frui" (XIX, 27 TCG); especially book XIX of the TCG. When talking about "conscience", there are various uses of this word. In the entry from the Introduction: Augustine (387-430) is one ... - there was an error. It should be (354-430).
